Dear Customer,

Aleris is a producer of Flat Rolled Aluminum Products. Historically, our company uses an average of 85 to 92% aluminum scrap during the production of the 1,98mm – 5754 H12 Coils we produce for Euramax Coated Products. The mix consists of 25 up to 30% post-consumer scrap and 70 up to 75 % pre-consumer aluminum scrap, depending on the availability of scrap material at any given time in our production cycle.

For clear understanding pre- and postconsumer scrap are defined as follows :

**Pre-consumer** waste is a material that was discarded before it was ready for consumer use. Pre-consumer waste is the reintroduction of manufacturing scrap (such as trimmings from slitting line production, defective aluminum cans, etc.) back into the manufacturing process. Pre-consumer waste is commonly used in manufacturing industries, and is often not considered recycling in the traditional sense.

**Post-consumer** waste is material discarded after someone uses it. Post-consumer waste has served its intended purpose, passed through the hands of a final consumer, and has been discarded for disposal or recovery. Quite commonly, it is simply the garbage that individuals routinely discard, either in the trash can or a dump, or by littering, incinerating, or pouring down the drain.
